Safety Directive Title	Boeing 737-8 and 737-9 (MAX) Aeroplanes – Return to Service	
Unsafe condition identified:	Prompted by two fatal accidents with Boeing 737-8 aeroplanes, and on based on the EASA SD 2019-01, Bosnia and Herzegovina published SD no. 1-1-14-3-236-1/19 dated 13.03.2019. do not to perform commercial air transport operations with Boeing 737-8 or Boeing 737-9 aeroplanes into, within of the territory Bosnia and Herzegovina.	
Required action(s)/measure(s), their rationale and compliance time(s):	Before the first commercial air transport flight performed by Boeing 737-8 and 737-9 aeroplanes into and within of the territory of the Bosnia and Herzegovina, the operator shall: (1) Implement all elements contained in Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) AD 2020-24-02, or in EASA AD 2021- 0039 or, where applicable, in an AD issued by the State of Registry that contains the same elements as FAA AD 2020-24- 02, or EASA AD 2021-0039. (2) Ensure all pilots operating flights have undergone the RTS	

training (see Note 1 of this SD) contained in FAA Flight
